## Dr. Silvia Rosas Lizárraga

is Geologist from the Peruvian National Engineering University and PhD from the University of Heidelberg. She was associate professor at the Pontifical Catholic University of Peru (PUCP) between 2002 and 2008, where she is now principal professor.

Since 2011 she is Head of the Mining Engineering Section which includes the new Geological Engineering career. During her tenure a large number of cooperation projects with companies and national and international institutions have been set.

She has been vice president of the Geological Society of Peru, is currently the coordinator for Peru of the international network "DAAD-Geo-Network of Latinamerican-German Alumni - GOAL" and the South American representative to the Executive Committee of the "World Forum of Universities of Resources on Sustainability - WFURS ".

She has participated in different international research programs and is currently involved in the project "Extinct carbonate ramps & platforms overwhelmed by siliceous sponges after the Triassic / Jurassic mass extinction (evidence from the USA and Peru), and its relation to ore deposits development", in cooperation with the University of Southern California and funded by the US-National Science Foundation.
